1. Complete the online application and upload your Statement of Purpose (500 word maximum) and your résumé/curriculum vitae.
2. Arrange for each college or university you attended to send an official transcript, and English language translation if applicable, directly to LSAC. Arrange for an official English language test (TOEFL or IELTS) score report to be sent by the testing company directly to LSAC.
3. Pay the application fee of \$65 (sixty-five U.S. dollars) online through LSAC.
4. Submit two letters of recommendation in sealed envelopes to UB School of Law Office of LL.M. Admissions, 1420 N. Charles St., Baltimore, MD 21201.
