



#### **Total Population**




#### **Juvenile Detention**


## **Percentage of Children Exposed to Violent Acts**

- Roper v. Simmons, 543 U.S. 551 (2005): Eliminates death sentence for juveniles
- *Graham v. Florida*, 130 S. Ct. 2011 (2010): Eliminates life without parole for juveniles in non-homicide offenses
- *Miller v. Alabama*, No. 10-9646 (2012): Eliminates life without the possibility of parole for juveniles

BETWEEN 3% AND 50% OF CHILDREN IN THE JUVENILE JUSTICE SYSTEM SUFFER FROM POST-TRAUMATIC STRESS DISORDER
